- The nominee must exhibit leadership qualities in volunteer service.
- The nominee must show initiative while providing a needed service in the Butler County community.
- The nominee's accomplishments/service should serve as a role model for others.
- The nominee acts in keeping with the YWCA mission of empowering women and eliminating racism.
